

PROVIDENCE EXTENDED DAY DISCIPLINE POLICY:

Extended Day students should report to the Dining Hall when school is dismissed. Their respective teachers will escort them to the main dining hall. As soon as students enter Extended Day, they are expected to take out their snacks and be seated. Homework will begin after snack and restroom time. Students should always keep books, workbooks, crossword puzzles and coloring sheets in their backpacks in case they do not have homework on occasion. They may also use that time to study. Please do not send toys to school as this may distract those who are attempting to complete homework. On Thursdays, Extended Day students may bring in items for Show and Tell.

Extended Day and Study Hall Conduct Rules & Expectations:

Walk, no running in the Dining Hall

Use inside voices (no screaming)

OUR DISCIPLINE POLICY IS AS FOLLOWS: when a child breaks a rule for the first time a verbal warning is given. Student and teacher signs referral form. Second offense, because a verbal warning has already been given child will be punished according to the child's actions. Placed in time out, made to stay inside while the other children are on the playground, etc. Parents will be notified in person or by phone. Third offense, because a verbal warning has been given and a punishment administered, the student is now being referred to the Dean for further disciplinary action.
