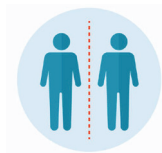
Not Feeling Well - If a student or visitor is not feeling well or is showing any symptoms such as fever, cough, or shortness of breath, please stay home and do not enter the campus.



Masks - Students and visitors must wear masks upon arrival. If you do not have a mask on hand, one will be provided for you.



Temperature Checks - To further support a healthy campus, we are asking families to perform a temperature check before coming to campus. If a student has a temperature of 100.4 or above, please have your student remain home until the fever has been gone for at least 24 hours without fever reducing medicine.



Social Distancing - While visiting campus, please work to maintain a six-foot distance.



Hand Sanitizer/Handwashing - Hand sanitizer is located throughout the building. Please wash your hands or use hand sanitizer frequently throughout the day.



Refillable Water Bottle Stations - To maintain social distancing and minimize touches, we ask you do not use the water fountains. Instead, please use the filtered water stations located throughout the building. Please have your student bring a refillable water bottle or bottled water.
