



Updated COVID 19 Guidelines

- Temperature screens for students/staff upon arrival is discontinued. Temperature screens will still be done on all adults that are not employed by the preschool.
- Drop off procedures – if you choose to walk your child up to the doors of the preschool, **a mask must be worn.** Car line is available and encouraged from 7:30am-8:05am. After this time, you will have to walk your child to the doors. Please make every attempt to arrive at the preschool by 8:15am. Late arrivals prevent staff from reporting to their classrooms on time and delays the start of the school day. Please expect to wait for a bit outside if you are arriving late to preschool. We have limited staff for intake after 8:15am.
- Pick up procedures after 3:30pm – one parent at a time may now enter **with mask on** and remain on the rug by the front door. Staff will retrieve children and bring them to the entrance area. Please stand socially distanced in line outside while waiting for your children. **Masks are required for all individuals over the age of 6.**
- In the event of exposure to COVID 19 and/or a positive COVID 19 case within your home, you must immediately notify the preschool director at lbenson@prov.org. Date of last exposure or date of positive test will be required. We will then confirm to you the quarantine period and when your child can return to preschool. A COVID log must be kept and completed. This log is required to be turned in upon return to preschool. For exposure outside the home, a quarantine of 7 days (with negative test result) or 10 days (without a test) will be required from the last date of exposure. For exposure within the home, a 14-day quarantine is required.
- If your child or a family member that resides at your residence is ill and/or displaying signs of COVID 19 where a COVID test is warranted, **we ask you to please keep your child at home until symptoms subside or a test result is received.** Basically, if anyone in your home feels the need to have a COVID test, please keep your child home until test results are received.
- Please be considerate and keep children at home when they are displaying any symptoms of sickness or if a family member is ill and there is a possibility of COVID. It is very important to us to always strive to keep our children and staff as safe as possible.
- We will continue to allow parents at outside events at this time, however, masks and social distancing from staff and other children must be followed. **In addition, if you are not well or think you were exposed, please do not attend an event at our school.** Not well includes any mild symptom, such as a sore throat, head ache etc....
- All other COVID guidelines distributed at the beginning of the school year are still in effect at this time.
