


## FOUND FORME

These food items will help restock the New Life Food Pantry, which plays an important role in feeding hungry neighbors year round, but especially during the holiday season. The Food drive will begin officially on October 10 and end on October 27. The class who participates the most (Lower, Middle, High) will receive a dress down day on November 1st as a "thank you" for such excellent participation.

- You may bring items in ANY DAY during the two-week window and leave them with your homeroom or first-period teacher.
- Students are to leave the items in their homeroom or first period class until chapel days (Thursdays, Upper school and Fridays, lower school) when they will be brought to the sanctuary for a blessing and tally. Lower School will bring their items over to the sanctuary at their scheduled chapel times.
- As always, items will be counted and the grade that contributes the most of their assigned items will receive a dress-down day on Wednesday, November 1. (Lower, middle, high will each have a winning grade.)

PRESCHOOL: Diapers (sizes 1-5) and wipes

KINDERGARTEN: Toothpaste and bar soap

1ST: Crackers and juice

2ND: Cereal and boxed or powdered milk

**3RD:** Peanut butter and jelly (plastic containers)

**4TH:** Canned soup and ramen noodles

**5TH:** Chef boyardee, canned pasta and canned chili

**6TH:** Applesauce (jars and 6 packs), canned fruit and 4-6 packs of fruit

7TH: Small laundry detergent (32 oz) and dish soap

8TH: Cans of peas, carrots and black beans

9TH: Canned tuna and canned chicken

10TH: Baked beans and pork & beans

11TH: Pancake mix and syrup

**12TH:** Boxed mashed potatoes and bags of rice

FACULTY & STAFF: Shampoos, deodorant, toilet paper,

feminine products, other toiletry items.

Please make sure dates of items are not expired. Plastic containers are preferred over glass
