

## AUDITION REQUIREMENTS/SONG SUGGESTIONS

Be prepared to sing 16 bars from a song in the show (preferably a song sung by the character you are auditioning for) You may also have 16 bars prepared from a song of your choosing:

- Ariel: Part of your world or the World Above Eric: Her Voice Ursala: Poor Unfortunate Souls Flotsam & Jetsom: Sweet Child, Daddy's Little Angel Scuttle: Positoovity, Human Stuff Flounder: She's in Love Mersisters: Daughters of Triton King Triton: If Only Sebastian: Under the Sea/Kiss the Girl Pilot, Sailors, Grimsby: Fathoms Below Chef Louis: Les Poissons Ensemble: Under the sea/Kiss the Girl
- Please fill out the audition form and the measurements page and bring them to your audition.
- You need to bring 3 audition forms but only 1 measurements page.
- Musical rehearsals are typically Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays after school.
  - Saturday morning rehearsals do take place in late February/March
  - You are only required to be at the rehearsals for scenes in which you are cast.
  - Unexcused absences from rehearsals will not be tolerated.
- You must maintain a C average to perform.
- You will sign up for a 10-minute audition period during the day.
  - You will get out of class for this audition. Please sign up for the time that has the least impact on class time. (i.e. not during a test)
  - Call-backs will be posted on Thursday 11/16/23 and will have a schedule for Friday call-backs

When taking measurements, consistency is very important. Please have all measurements taken by a responsible adult.

Use a tape measure or ribbon and take measurements indicated by the diagram above. Record them (by inches) in the chart below, then check for accuracy.

Α	BUST – circumference taken around greatest fullness	
В	WAIST – smallest circumference taken around natural waistline; not necessarily where an actor wears his or her pants!	
С	HIPS – circumference taken around greatest fullness	
D	BACK WIDTH – taken across back from shoulder to shoulder	
E	FRONT CHEST – taken across front from shoulder to shoulder	
F	SHOULDER – taken from base of neck along top to outside of shoulder	
G	NECK SIZE – circumference taken around base of neck	
н	SLEEVE – taken from shoulder to wrist around bent arm	
J	<b>UNDER BUST</b> – circumference of upper rib cage just under bust	
Ν	WRIST – circumference taken around greatest fullness	
0	<b>UPPER ARM</b> – circumference taken around greatest fullness	
Ρ	<b>CALF</b> – circumference taken around greatest fullness	
R	ANKLE – circumference taken around greatest fullness	
G-B	NAPE to WAIST – taken from base of neck to natural waist in back	
B-C	WAIST to HIP – taken from natural waist to greatest fullness at hip	
F-B	FRONT SHOULDER to WAIST – taken from center point of shoulder to natural waist	
K-M	OUTSIDE LEG – outseam taken from natural waistline to just below ankle bone	
L-M	INSIDE LEG – inseam taken from crotch to just below ankle bone	
	HAT – circumference taken around head above ears	
F+H	SLEEVE LENGTH – taken from prominent neck vertebrae across shoulder to wrist	
	NAPE to FLOOR – taken from base of neck to floor in back
