Reading Assignment Overview:

Students will select four (4) novels from the designated reading list below over the course of the school year. At the end of each quarter, students will:

1. Take a customized comprehension test based on the novel they selected.
2. Submit a written book report reflecting on the novel's content and themes.

Important Note:

While some of these novels may have been adapted into films or television series, students are expected to read the books themselves. The comprehension tests and book reports are based solely on the content of the novels—not the adaptations. Watching a film version in place of reading the book will not adequately prepare students for the assessment and defeats the purpose of this initiative. Our goal is to foster a genuine reading habit that contributes to the formation of well-rounded, thoughtful, and informed individuals.
